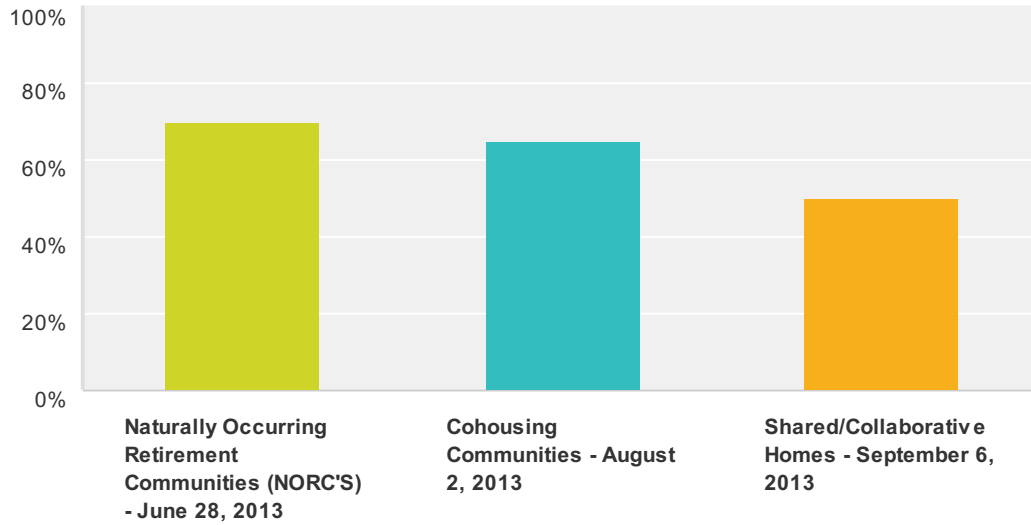

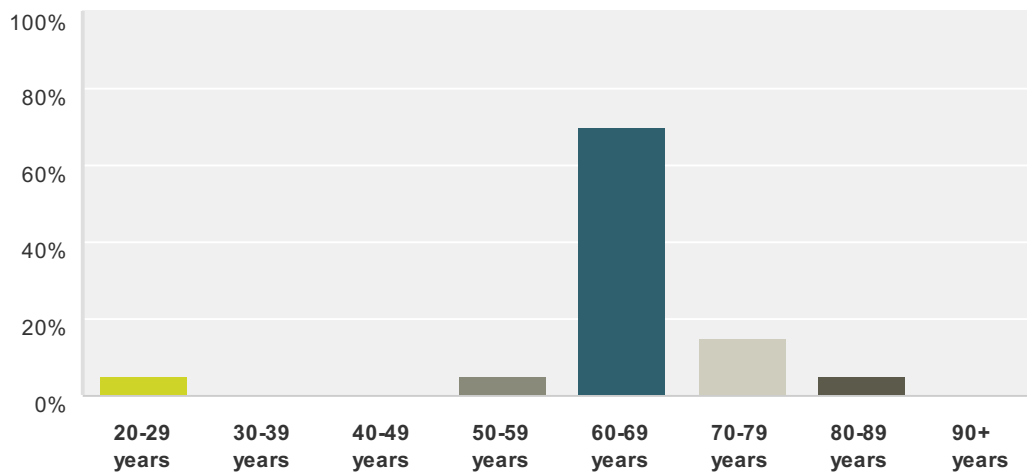

## Q2 Which of the following best describes your age range?

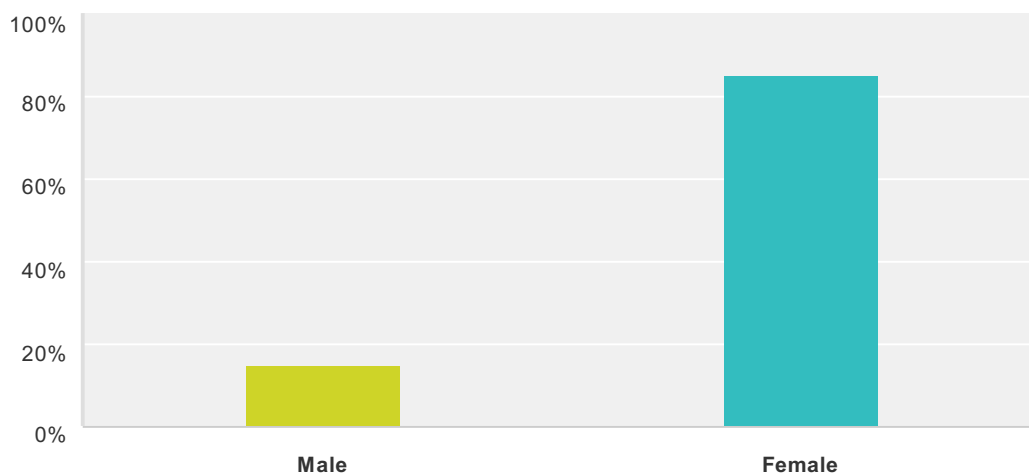

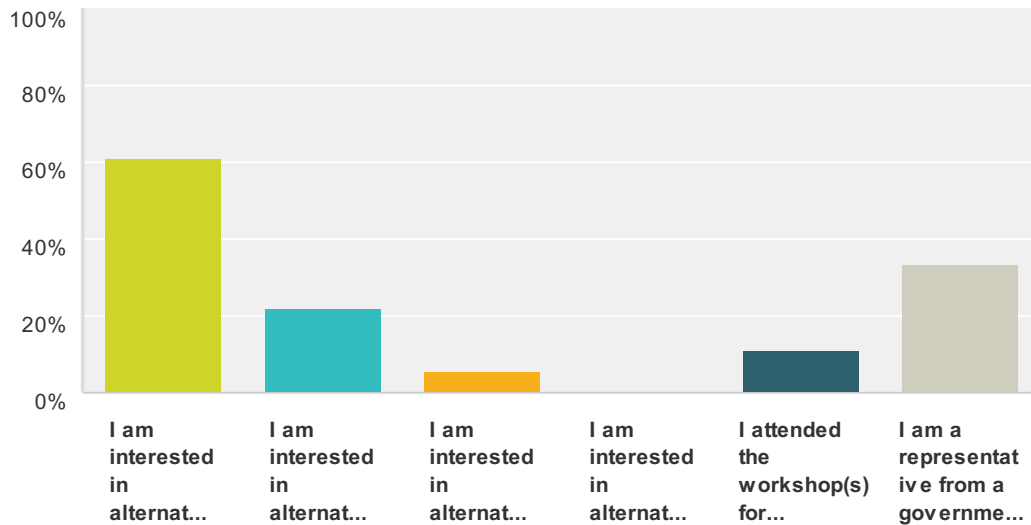

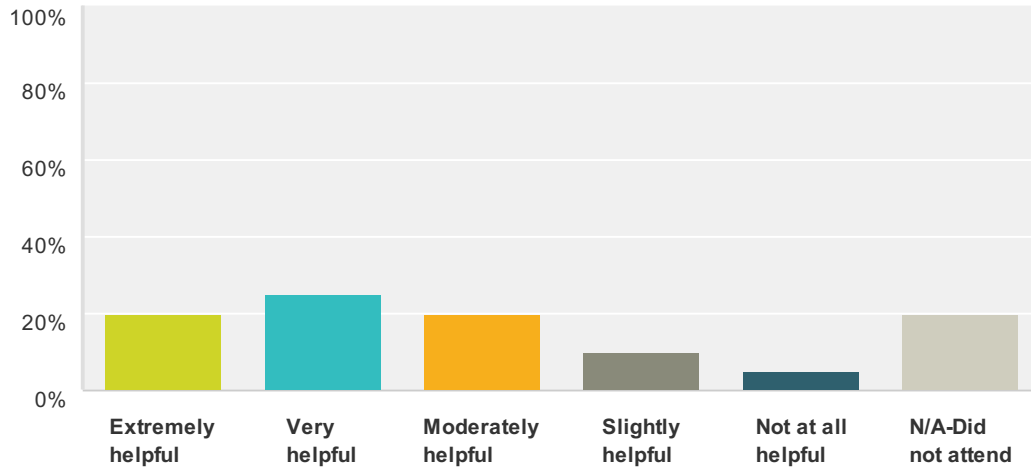

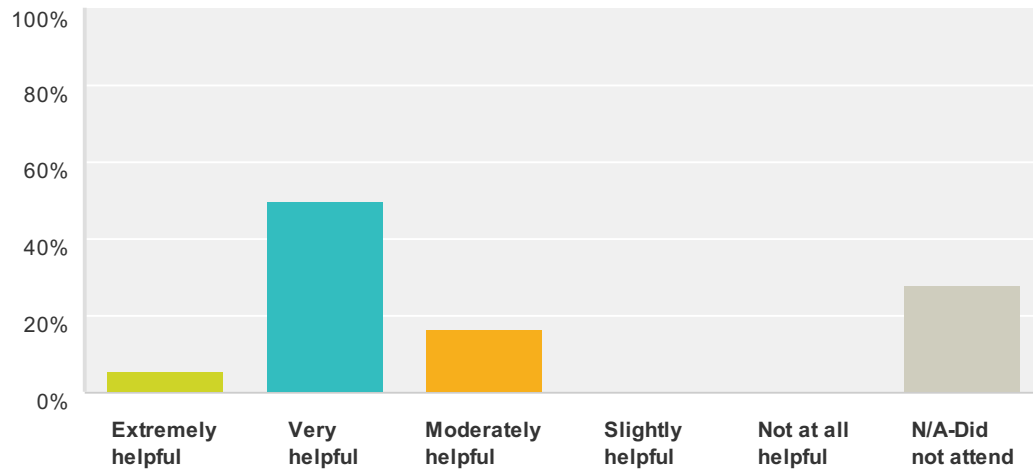

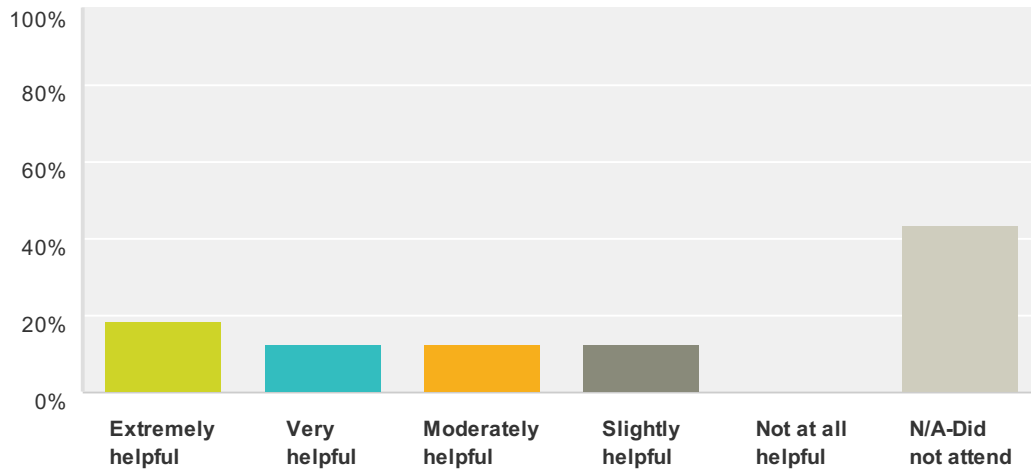

**Q9 Please rate the overall usefulness of the information from the Shared/Collaborative Homes workshop (September 6, 2013).**

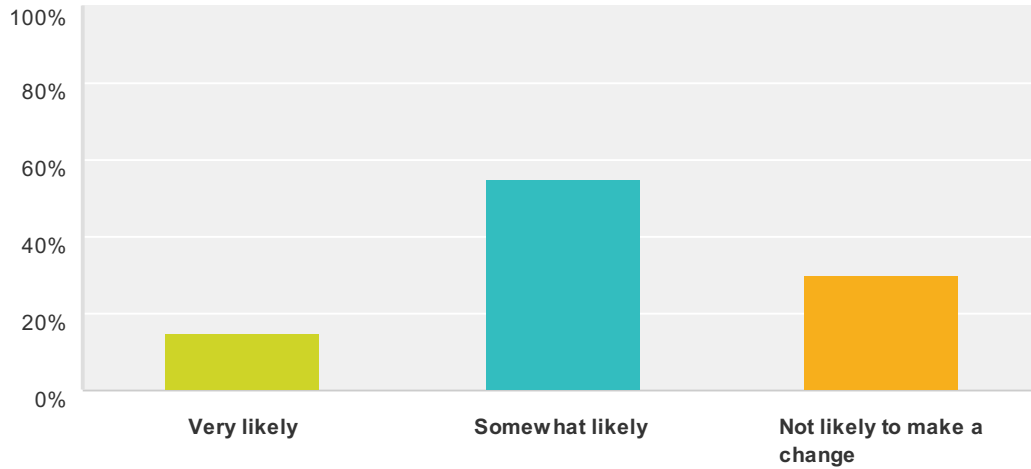

### Q10 How likely are you to make a change in your living situation as a result of the information offered through the workshop series?

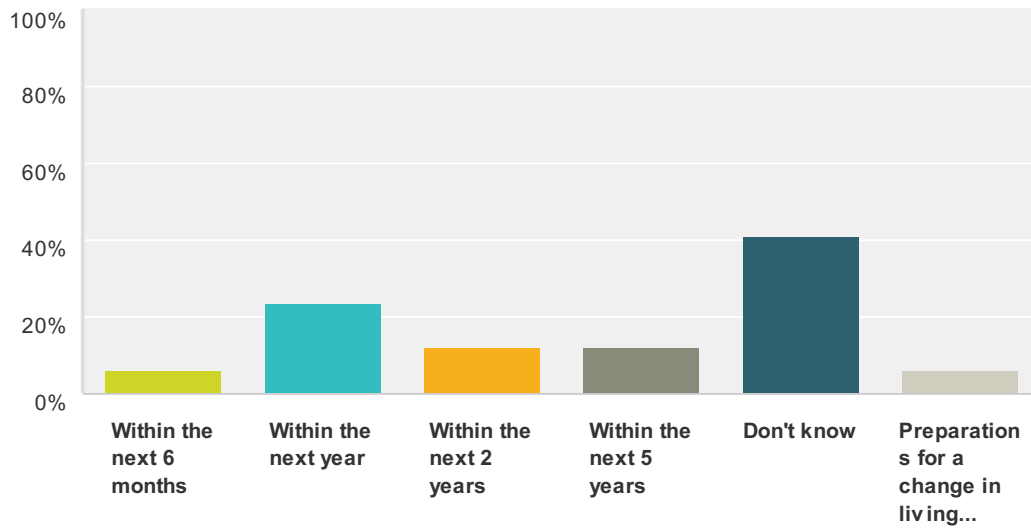

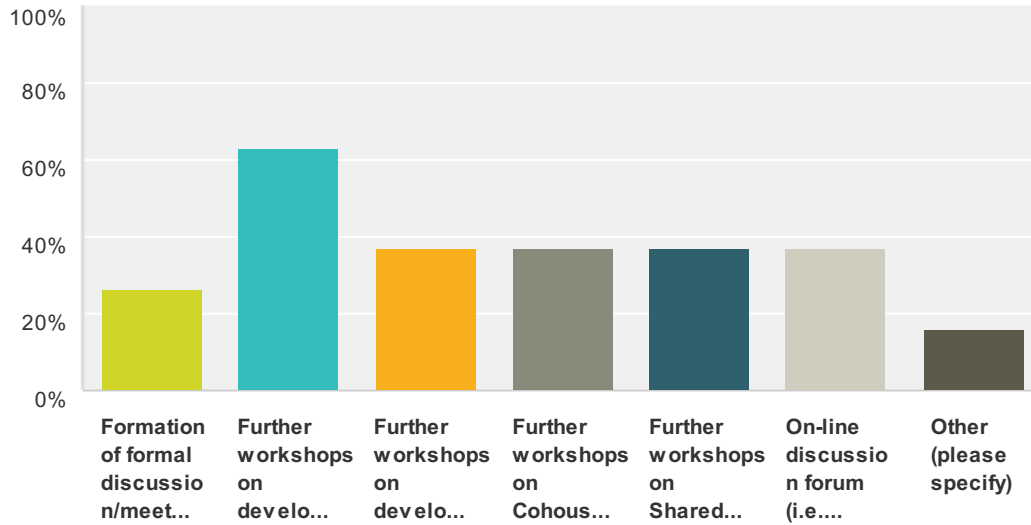
